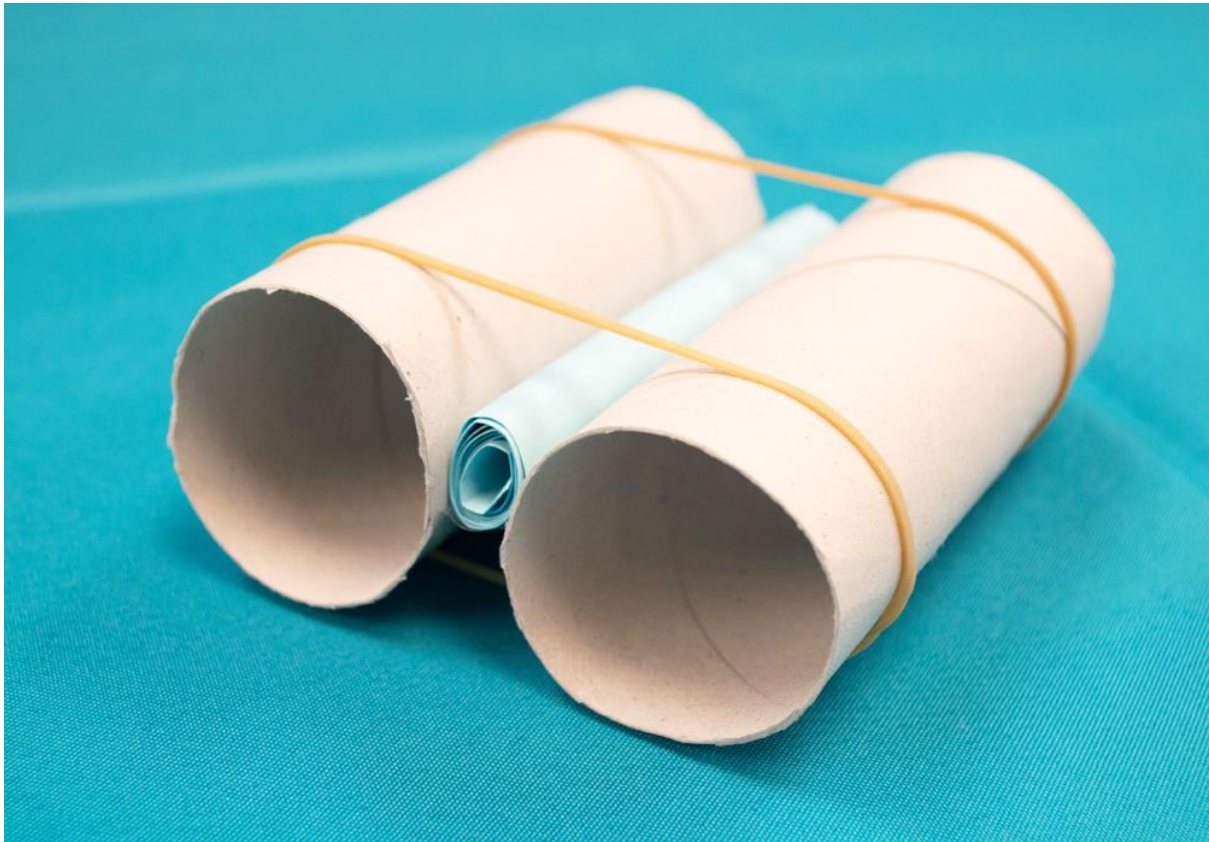


# Mini Beast Toilet Roll Bugs

Use toilet rolls to create mini beasts. Add cardboard, pipe cleaners, straws, twigs, string, anything you have to hand to add the details to the insects.



And then you will need to make some Binoculars to hunt for your mini beast bugs!



Completing these activities with your child will cover the following areas of the EYFS

**Physical development** (the coordination it takes to stick and join items together),  
**Communication and Language development** (following instructions and talking to each other, the questions that can arise from this type of activity "where could this go?" "What happens if we add this?" "what else could this type of mini beast have?"), ,  
**Numeracy** (shapes, colours), **Exploring the world** (using different materials, talking about their textures and properties), **Expressive Art and Design** (the design of the mini beast).
