Scavenger Hunts

After some positive feedback about the scavenger hunts that I have posted, I have found another two which are numeracy based and will help your child to think critically. You can also take this opportunity to use the found items to practice phonics; what <u>sound</u> does the item start with? What is the middle <u>sound</u>? What is the <u>sound</u> at the end? Can you blend the <u>sounds</u>? Can you write the <u>sounds</u>?

If your child is not at this stage, please do no panic, just enjoy the hunt for what it is.

BIGGER OR SMALLER SCAVENGER HUNT

- Find something bigger than a crayon but smaller than a banana.
- Find something bigger than a coin but smaller than a clock.
- Find something bigger than a shoe but smaller than a pillow.
- Find something bigger than a paper clip but smaller than a water bottle.
- Find something bigger than a clipboard but smaller than a door.
- Find something bigger than a toy car but smaller than a plate.
- Find something bigger than a TV remote but smaller than the couch.

TALLER OR SHORTER SCAVENGER HUNT

- Find something taller than a table but shorter than a door.
- Find something taller than a pencil but shorter than a dresser.
- Find something taller than a cereal box but shorter than a chair.
- Find something taller than a book but shorter than the kitchen counter.
- Find something taller than a spatula but shorter than you.
- Find something taller than a ball but shorter than a tree.
- Find something taller than a shoe but shorter than a ruler.
