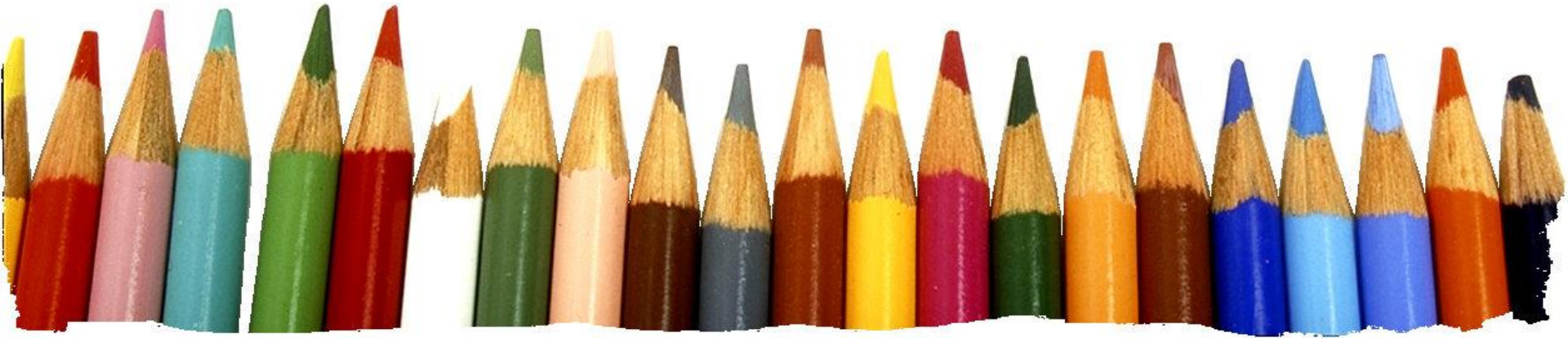

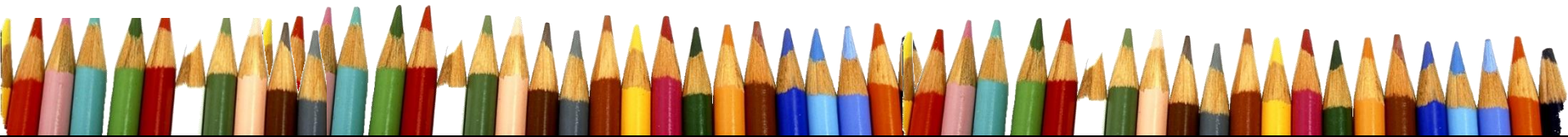
Literacy

- Daily Phonics – Get Spelling
- Recap Year 1 and 2 Key Words
- Start learning the Year 3 and 4 Key Words
- Spellings – weekly test
- Cover a range of genres throughout the year – including both fiction, non-fiction and poetry



Literacy

- Range of punctuation accurately – **capital letters, full stops, question marks,** exclamation marks, commas, apostrophes and inverted commas (speech marks)
- Use a range of conjunctions – **or, and, but, when, if, that, because,** before, after, while, so
- Make deliberate ambitious word choices to add detail and interest to their writing



Literacy

- Use paragraphs to organise their writing
- Use subordinate clauses
- To use conjunctions, adverbs and prepositions to show time, place and cause
- To use 'a' and 'an' correctly in their independent writing
- Maintain the correct tense within a piece of writing



Numeracy

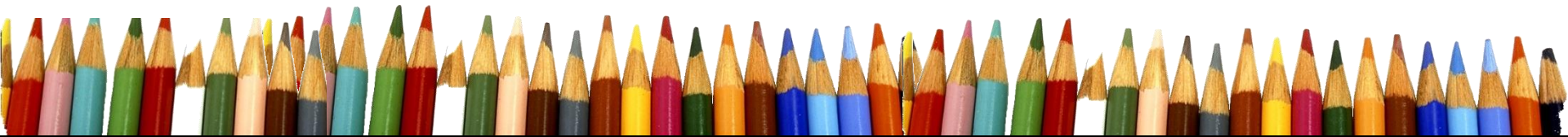
- Times Tables – daily
- Times Tables Record – school
- Photocopy will be in the back of their reading records
- Achieve their bronze, silver and gold in each times tables by the end of year 4
- At the end of year 4, children will have a computerised times table test

- Recap the 2, 5 and 10 times tables

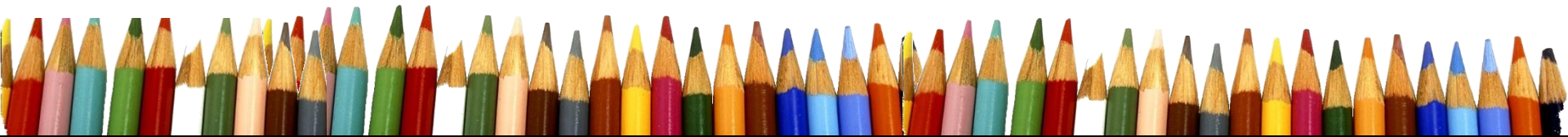

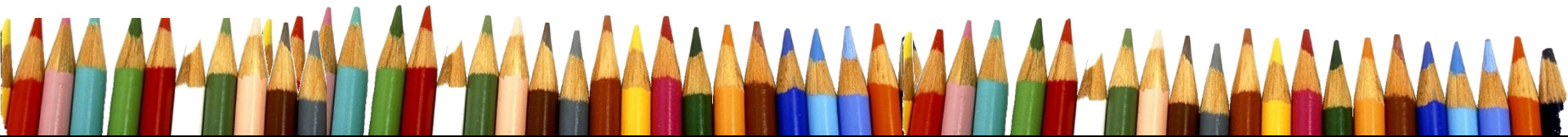

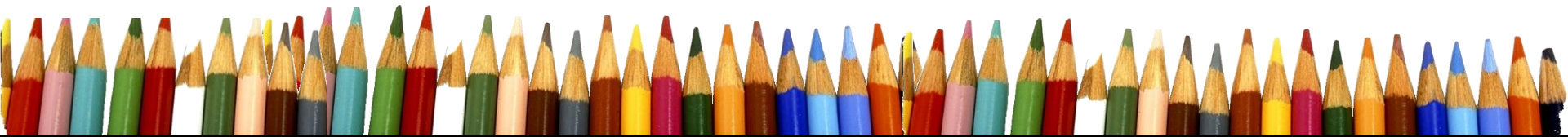
Numeracy

- White Rose Maths –
- Place Value – recap numbers to 100, partitioning numbers to 1000, count in 50s
- Adding and Subtracting – number bonds to 100, 3digit and 2digit numbers (e.g. $265-89$ or $685+88$), inverse operations, applying knowledge to word problems



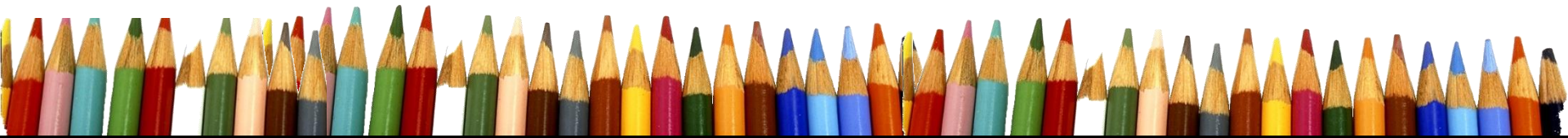
Numeracy

- Multiplication and Division – multiples of 2, 5 and 10, looking at the 2, 4 and 8 times tables including the division facts
- Length and perimeter
- Fractions
- Mass and capacity
- Money

P.E.

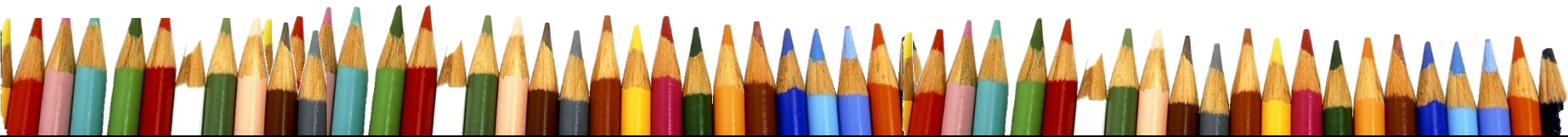
- Every Wednesday afternoon

- Friday – Spelling and Big Maths test



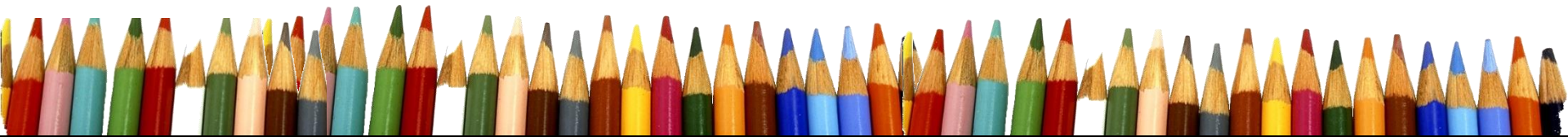
It's Good to be Green

- 3 consequence cards – invite parents in for a meeting

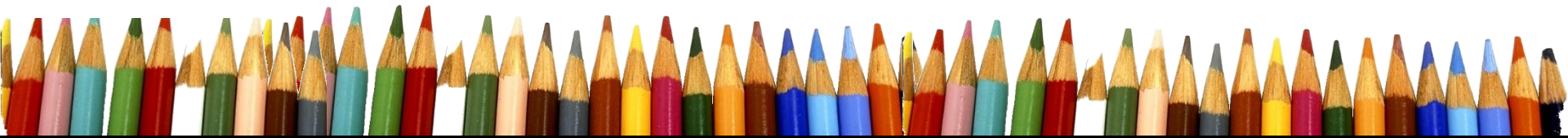


Expectations and Standards
